ANNUAL REPORT – 2021-22

I hereby present the annual report for the year 2021-22.

The school re-opened on Tuesday, 1st June for the academic year 2021-22 in the online mode because of the pandamic. Due to the surge in the Covid cases, the Board exams for classes 10 and12 were cancelled and a new assessment scheme was introduced in which the students of class 10 & 12 scored well.

In the class 10 examination, 17 of them, Anson Shibu, Niya Joseph, Niya Abraham, Arshitha Biju, Nibin George, Neil Yakob Kocherie, Aaron George Mattappillil, Anitto Jeemon Mundakkal, Sneha Jaison, Eaviline Sheba Varghese, Arundhathy Vinod, Nripa Treesa Jortin, Prem Sai Sreekumar, Megha S, Emil Phil Vinod, Treasa George and Abhirami Biju got A1 in all subjects. Six of them got A1 in four subjects and 25 of them secured above 90%. Anson Shibu, the highest scorer got 100 marks in Mathematics, Social Science and IT.

In the class 12 examination, 16 of them, Nanda S Kurup, Aleena Gemmy Francis, Chhayank Prasanth, Jewel Elsa Johnson, Nahan Shameer, Gourinathan M, Jahnavi A S, Aditi S Gokul, Donna Elza Jimmy, Gourinandhan M, Nandana Suresh, Nandhana S Biju, Sebastian Antony, Sidharth Puthiya Veedu, Mathew Francis and Abhinav Anil got A1 in all subjects, 32 of them got A1 in four subjects and 59 of them scored above 90%. Nanda S Kurup and Aleena Gemmy Francis were the school toppers in the Science and Commerce stream respectively.

In the NEET Examination our students Nanda S Kurup, Jackson Pius Thaliath, Abhinav Anil, Chhayank Prasanth, Sidharth Tharun, Neetha P Rasheeth, Sidharth Puthiya Veedu, Naazni Salim, Gayathri Binu and Linet Jose got admission in various Government Medical Colleges and Self-financing Medical Colleges. Gourinandan M, Gourinathan M, Gokul Krishna Vinod, Niloopher Shirin and Jayalakshmi Prasad, Deepak P P and Emilin Feba Varghese got exceptional scores in the KEAM 2021.

All the teachers attended orientation programmes virtually organised by CBSE.

Mr. Joji Paul conducted a career development orientation class for the students of classes 9, 10 and 12 in the beginning of the academic year.

Dr.Presoon Kuruvilla, Caritas Hospital conducted an informative session for teachers, parents, and students on the after effects of Covid.

Mr. George Pulickan conducted an interesting and enlightening session on the topic 'Back to School' for students and parents after an year of the pandemic.
