### **The New Academic Year**

### **Board Exam Results**

Our students came out in flying colours in the AISSCE and AISSE exams of 2021-22 with class 12 students , Haniyah Riyaz, Vishnu Vijayaraj and Vaishnavi Vijayaraj achieving top scores of 100 in the subjects of Maths, Chemistry and Biology. 12 students scored A1 in all subjects.

Anuja S Nair obtained 100 marks in all subjects in the AISSE examination becoming the topper in the Kottiyam Region. 12 students of class 10 also scored A1 for all subjects

Our students also contributed in including the name of Mary Mount among the top schools in the AIIMS and IIT categories.

Our students performed extremely well **at Comarina Junior Commerce Fest organized by St Thomas College , Palai** bagged many prizes and an amount of Rs 15000 in various events like Business Quiz, Business Plan Presentation and Best Management.

Our school emerged Runner up in the **Interschool Fest** organized by **BMM Senior Secondary, Pampady** winning a cash prize of Rs 3000 for Quiz competition and various places in the events of Treasure Hunt, Best Management and Role play. Neil Yakob and Shraddha Sunil Jose was chosen as the best Logical Speaker and best speaker in the Debate competition held in Excelsior English School and Ann Maria Jaish got consolation prize for Malayalam Essay competition also.

### **Skill Hub**

To develop the skills of children , CBSE introduced the concept of skill hub which was successfully implemented with the help of the IT department under the leadership of Mr. Sinish and Ms. Sethulakshmy through a 3 month course on domestic data entry operator The course attended by 10 students commenced on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2022 and was competed on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and each of them earned a Skill India Logo certificate after theory and practical exam. The whole course was conducted in the hybrid mode.

### **Hub of Schools**

CBSEs new venture the hub of learning which started in 2019 and has been taken up again this year is a new landmark of learning where a group of schools come together with the intention of sharing knowledge, teaching methods and other resources for enhancing the standards. Mary Mount Public School was selected by the CBSE to act as the lead school and our school provides support to 7 neighbouring CBSE Schools.
